

## Intervals for Trinity Guildhall Aural test up to Grade 5

Minor 2 <sup>nd</sup>	White Christmas
Major 2 <sup>nd</sup>	Happy Birthday
Minor 3 <sup>rd</sup>	Greensleeves – the only one at this grade that sounds sad
Major 3 <sup>rd</sup>	Oh When the Saints
Perfect 4 <sup>th</sup>	On Ilkley Moor Ba t'at or Oh Little Town of Bethlehem
Perfect 5 <sup>th</sup>	Twinkle Twinkle Little Star
Minor 6 <sup>th</sup>	Love Story theme
Major 6 <sup>th</sup>	My Bonnie Lies Over the Ocean
Minor 7 <sup>th</sup>	Somewhere (from West Side Story) or Star Trek theme
Major 7 <sup>th</sup>	Somewhere Over the Rainbow (1 <sup>st</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> notes)
Octave	Somewhere Over the Rainbow (1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> notes)

Grades 1 and 2 Pupils must say if the last note of a short piece is higher, lower or the same as the first note.

Grade 3 Major/minor 3<sup>rd</sup>, Perfect 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>

Grade 4 Minor 2<sup>nd</sup>, Major/minor 3<sup>rd</sup>, Perfect 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>  
Major/Minor 6<sup>th</sup>, Octave

Grade 5 All the intervals above
